5. Rental Terms and Conditions

1. The RENTER shall keep and maintain the rented trailer during the rental period at Renter's own cost and expense. Renter shall keep the trailer in a good state of repair during the rental period.
2. The RENTER shall pay the OWNER full compensation for full replacement of any trailer which is not returned because it is lost or stolen and/or repair including parts and labor of any trailer which is damaged and in need of repair to put it into the same condition it was in at the time of rental (normal wear and tear excepted). The OWNER's invoice for replacement or repair is conclusive as to the amount RENTER shall pay under this paragraph for repair or replacement.
3. The RENTER shall inform the OWNER upon demand of the exact location of the trailer at any time while it is in the RENTER's possession. Trailers are not to be taken outside the State of Texas without prior WRITTEN consent from Pop's Trailer Rental (the "Owner").
4. The trailer shall be delivered to RENTER and returned to OWNER at the RENTER's risk, cost and expense. If a periodic rental rate is charged by OWNER, rental charges are billed to the RENTER for each period or portions of the period from the time the trailer is delivered to RENTER until its return. If a term rental rate is charged by OWNER, rental charges are billed to the RENTER for the full term even if the trailer is returned before the end of the term. If the trailer is not returned during or at the end of the term, then the rental charges shall continue on a full-term basis for any additional term or portion thereof until the trailer is returned.
5. No allowance will be made for any rented trailer or portion thereof which is claimed not to have been used. Acceptance of returned trailer by OWNER does not constitute a waiver of any of the rights OWNER has under this rental agreement.
6. If the RENTER is in default of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement, the OWNER, and its agents, at the RENTER's risk, cost and expense may at any time enter the premises where the rented trailer is stored or used and recover the rented trailer.
7. The RENTER shall not pledge or encumber the rented trailer in any way. The OWNER may terminate this agreement immediately upon the failure of RENTER to make rental payments when due, or upon RENTER's filing for protection from creditors in any court of competent jurisdiction.
8. The OWNER makes no warranty of any kind regarding the rented trailer, except that OWNER shall replace the trailer with an identical or similar trailer if the trailer fails to operate in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications and operation instructions. Such replacement shall be made as soon as practicable after RENTER returns the non-conforming trailer.
9. RENTER indemnifies and holds OWNER harmless for all injuries or damage of any kind arising from repossession and for all consequential and special damages for any claimed breach of warranty, to the maximum extent permitted by law.
10. The RENTER shall pay all reasonable attorney and other fees, expenses and costs incurred by OWNER in protecting its rights under this rental agreement and for any action taken by OWNER to collect any amounts due under this rental agreement.
11. These terms are accepted by the RENTER upon delivery of the terms to the RENTER or the agent or other representative of RENTER, and by signing below.
12. A rental day is twenty-four (24) hours. Trailers are charged for time out, not time used. Overtime may be charged at one-sixth (1/6) of the applicable daily rate per overtime hour unless otherwise agreed in writing.
13. You are responsible for all damage to, or loss or theft of, the trailer, including damage caused by weather, road conditions and acts of nature, whether or not you are at fault, subject to this Agreement. You must report all accidents involving the Trailer to OWNER AND the Police within four (4) hours of occurrence or discovery.

6. Trailer Rental Policies (summary; Agreement controls)

Care & Cleaning

All rentals are made with the understanding that normal wear and tear is included in the rental rate. Damage from misuse or improper care will be charged. Trailers must be returned reasonably clean or additional charges may apply.

Deposits

A deposit of \$200.00 is required unless credit has been established in advance. Deposit may be paid by approved credit or debit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express), prepaid card, cash, or check as accepted by Owner at time of rental.

Tires - Road Damage - Flat Tires

Before operating the rental trailer, check the jobsite and roadway for debris or terrain that could damage tires. In most instances, tire damage is caused by jobsite or roadway conditions; payment for ALL tire repairs during the rental period is the responsibility of the customer. In the event of a flat tire, the customer may call a tire repair company of their choice, or Pop's Trailer Rental may arrange repair at the sole expense of the Customer. Pop's Trailer Rental is NOT responsible for tire damage during the rental period. Please inspect tires prior to rental.

Operating Condition

Owner will perform an inspection WITH Renter prior to delivery when practicable. If the trailer is not operating as it should, contact Pop's Trailer Rental immediately at (469) 261-9589. Continuing to run the trailer with a malfunction can cause excess wear, tear, and damage. If you do not report a problem and wait until return, you may be held responsible for the full cost of repairs required to return the unit to operational condition.

Identification & Insurance

Renting requires: (1) Valid Texas driver's license, Military ID, or Texas State ID card (or other ID accepted by Owner); (2) Year, make and license # of renter's tow vehicle; (3) Proof of current insurance.

Reservations & Past Due

Reserve in advance when possible. Reservations may be held for a limited time (e.g., 30 minutes) unless a deposit is taken. Trailer is past due if not returned by the due date and time on this contract.

Weekend Special

When booked as a Weekend Special, the rate is \$250.00 total for Friday pickup through Sunday return as one rental period, not stacked with daily weekday/weekend rates. Exact pickup and return clock times are as written in Section 4 of this Agreement.

Towing & Hitch Requirements

Tandem axle trailers require a suitable tow vehicle. Owner recommends a van or truck with a 2 5/16 inch ball and adequate hitch class (typically Class 3 or better for this unit). Short-wheelbase passenger cars are generally not appropriate due to tongue height and stability. Owner reserves the right to decline any vehicle believed unsafe or inappropriate. Minimum wheelbase guidance of 133 inches may apply for tandem-axle units; some larger trailers require a 3/4-ton or larger chassis. Hitch/ball must be solid machined and properly sized; bushings to increase shank size should not be used.

Delivery (if offered)

Delivery may be available for an additional fee by arrangement. Delivery charges vary by distance. Rental rates on delivered trailers are a minimum one-day charge. Customer must call to request pickup of the trailer; Owner does not automatically pick up when the rental ends. Failure to request timely pickup may result in additional rental charges.
